Campsmount LEARN SPARX

Our new approach to homework is working wonderfully with a high level of engagement and completion in all years over 95% every day.

Maths is an exciting aspect of homework as it uses the online program SPARX to target your child with appropriately levelled questions linked to learning in lessons. This communication is designed to give you more clarity as a parent of the expectations of your child and what we, the academy, and you can do to support your child with their SPARX homework.

What does your child need?

- 1. A device with internet access as this is an online task.
- 2. A log in to SPARX your child has been provided with this by their maths teacher.
- 3. Pre-planned time to complete SPARX tasks.

What are the expectations of your child?

It is expected that all students complete 100% of the SPARX tasks.

Students will write their answers in their planners on the Friday 'Maths LEARN page' along with the code that each correct answer provides.

100% completion will only show on your child's home screen on SPARX when all questions are correctly completed.

Some tasks provide a higher level of challenge. Your child may need support with these questions. Support can be accessed in the following ways:

- 1. Your child's maths teacher.
- 2. The support videos on SPARX.
- 3. Homework club Monday to Thursday 3.00pm-3.45pm.
- 4. You and your child working together using the SPARX support.

Starting SPARX earlier in the week would help students to access all of this support.

Each Friday Mrs Webb, our Academy SPARX Coordinator, will download a report from SPARX detailing completion and engagement from the SPARX learning platform. This will be used to allocate Campsmount LEARN Reward points. The Academy has awarded over 3,500 reward points to students for completing homework since launching our new approach.
