Behaviour Expectations on Public Transport

I am writing to inform you of a recent issue regarding vandalism on the bus that picks up students outside of the school. We have been made aware of damage caused by some of our students while travelling to and from school. This behaviour is unacceptable and does not reflect the high standards we expect from our students.

When wearing the school uniform, our students represent the school, and we expect them to always demonstrate respect and responsibility, including on their journey to and from school. We would like to remind all families that inappropriate behaviour on the bus, including vandalism, will not be tolerated.

If any further damage occurs, the families of those responsible will be charged for the cost of repairs. Additionally, the bus company has the authority to ban students from using the service if their behaviour does not meet the expected standards.

We kindly ask for your support in reinforcing these expectations with your child. Please discuss the importance of behaving responsibly on the bus and treating both the transport and its driver with respect.
