<b>School Opening Time</b>	8:15am Students should arrive between 8:15–8:25 to be ready for a prompt start
<b>Uniform Expectations</b>	Academy blazer and tie, white shirt tucked in, academy skirt or black trousers, and black leather shoes. No hoodies, extreme hairstyles/colours, false nails, eyelashes, or jewellery. <a href="#">Academy Uniform</a>

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<b>Equipment Requirements</b>	Black pen, pink pen, pencil, ruler, eraser, and a suitable school bag. A 30-minute detention will be issued for not bringing the correct equipment
