Hot Weather Arrangements and Sports Day Update

Due to the exceptionally high temperature forecast for the remainder of this week, we have made the difficult decision to cancel our planned Sports Day, which was due to take place on Thursday 26th June 2026.

The safety and wellbeing of our students and staff must always be our highest priority, and after carefully considering the forecast conditions, we do not feel it would be appropriate to proceed with the event.

We understand that many students were looking forward to Sports Day and we share their disappointment. We are currently reviewing the school calendar to explore whether it may be possible to reschedule the event later in the year. Should an alternative date be identified, we will communicate this as soon as possible.

I would like to reassure you that Campsmount Academy will remain open as normal, and we expect all students to attend school as usual throughout the remainder of the week.

To help students remain comfortable in the warmer weather, we will be allowing students to attend school in their **full Campsmount PE kit** for the rest of this week.

Please note the following expectations:



- Students must wear their **full** Campsmount PE kit.
- Trainers must be worn.
- Students should bring a refillable water bottle to school each day. Water refill stations will be available throughout the school.
- Crop tops, hot pants, cycling shorts and other coloured non-Campsmount branded PE tops are not permitted.
- False eyelashes, acrylic nails and jewellery remain prohibited and should not be worn to school.
- Students may wear a sun hat during social times (before school, break and lunchtime); however, hats must be removed during lessons and when inside the building.
- We recommend that sun cream with a high protection factor is applied before school each morning.
