Dear Parents,

Following our recent start-of-term letter, we would like to remind you of our expectations regarding mobile phones.

From **1st September 2026, new Department for Education statutory guidance requires schools to operate a mobile phone-free school day**. At Campsmount Academy, phones must therefore remain switched off and out of sight throughout the school day, including lessons, lesson changeovers, break and lunchtime. If a phone is seen or heard during the school day, it will be confiscated and parents/carers will be asked to collect it from Reception.

This is an important part of our approach to keeping children safe, as well as supporting a calm and focused environment for learning.

Contacting Your Child

If you need to contact your child during the school day, please contact Reception. A message can then be passed on to your child.

Students should not use their mobile phone to contact parents or carers during the school day. Where a student has to contact home for an important reason, this can be facilitated through student services.

Thank you for your continued support in helping us to keep our students safe and maintain a positive environment for learning.
