- You should login to Teams using your Academy email address and password.
- You should behave as if you were in a real classroom at school. Be positive, polite and respectful at all times.
- You will have to dress appropriately for Live Video Sessions.
- You must not record or take screenshots during Live Video Sessions.
- During Live Video Sessions, you should take your surroundings into account, including the
 other people in your household. Position yourself to give a plain background use the
 blurred background feature on Teams or even consider turning your video feed off
 altogether.
