

# Campsmount Academy Uniform Guidance Academic Year 2020/2021



At Campsmount Academy we believe school uniform is important as it contributes to a sense of belonging and fosters a feeling of pride within our school community.

From 1<sup>st</sup> July 2020, Campsmount Academy uniform will only be available to purchase from SWI Schoolwear (with the exception of ties and sports socks; which can also be purchased from reception). Orders can be placed online (see link on the uniform page on the Campsmount Academy website for guidance) or a telephone order can be placed (please see link on uniform page on the Campsmount Academy website for an order form or contact reception).

To assist you with ordering, you will also find a sizing guide on the uniform page of the Campsmount Academy website.

We recommend that all orders are placed on or before **Monday 3rd August 2020** ready for the start of term. Although this is not a cut-off date, we advise ordering early to ensure students have their items in plenty of time before the start of term.

Items ordered from SWI Schoolwear are only currently available for home delivery. We are hoping to arrange for weekly deliveries to school in the new academic year but we will notify parents when this option becomes available.

Our school uniform consists of:

## **Blazers**

All students are required to wear the Campsmount Blazer. Blazers are to be worn at all times with sleeves rolled down. **Blazers must be purchased from SWI Schoolwear** (see guidance on Academy website for how to order).

## **Shirts**

All students **MUST** wear a cotton-type plain white shirt or blouse with a collar. These can be long or short sleeved. **Shirts can be purchased from SWI Schoolwear or can be purchased from other retailers.**

The shirt/blouse must be long enough to be able to be tucked into trousers or a skirt. Shirts/blouses must button up to the top (up to the collar).

## **Trousers / Skirts**

Trousers should be plain black and should not be jean-type material. A helpful description would be 'suit-type material'. If trousers have 'studs' on, they will be deemed to be jeans. They should be loose fitting and should not be 'skinny-fit'.

Trousers should take a belt so that students' underwear is not visible.

Skirts may be worn by girls but must be of an appropriate length (ie knee length).

Skirts should be plain black and should be worn with plain black tights.

**Suitable trousers and skirts can be purchased from SWI Schoolwear or can be purchased from other retailers.**

**\*\*\*Plans are in place to launch a new style skirt for girls, however this has been delayed due to the outbreak of coronavirus. Additional information will be shared with parents once it is available and until then an appropriate knee length black skirt (as detailed above) should be worn \*\*\***

## **Ties**

Students must wear a tie at all times. A black and gold broad striped tie is available for students in year groups 7-10 and black and gold thin striped tie is available for our year 11 students.

Ties must be clipped over the fastened top button.

**Ties can be purchased from SWI Schoolwear or from reception at Campsmount Academy at a cost of £6.60 for year groups 7-10 and £7.00 for year 11 students.**

## **V-neck jumper (Optional)**

A plain black V-neck jumper can be worn under the blazer during the winter months.

## **Footwear**

Students must wear 'sensible shoes' that are suitable and safe to wear around Campsmount and in lessons. This means that shoes must be plain black, leather-type shoes. There must not be any colourful trim or logos on shoes.

Students must not wear trainers anywhere in the school buildings (except for PE); but trainers can be worn **to walk to** school, at break, at lunch and to go home.

## **PE Kit**

Our students are required to wear a uniform for PE.

Our school PE kit consists of:

- Campsmount Polo shirt
- Campsmount Shorts, or Campsmount female leggings or Campsmount training pants
- Campsmount Sports socks
- Campsmount ¼ zip, long sleeved training top (**this is an optional item, however if students would like to wear a long sleeved top for PE, the Campsmount top from SWI Schoolwear must be purchased**)

**PE kit must be purchased from SWI Schoolwear\*** (see guidance on Academy website for how to order)

\*We do hold a small stock of sports socks in reception which are available to purchase at a costs of £6.00 per pair.

We recommend the use of shin pads for football activities and mouth guards for rugby activities.

### **Other uniform rules:**

- No extreme hairstyles or colours
- False nails are not allowed
- Nail polish is not allowed
- Minimal, discreet makeup
- No jewellery (other than a watch), students must not wear any piercings or have body modifications
- Students must carry a suitable bag
- Outdoor clothing must not be worn inside the building
