Summary:

The qualification is split into 3 components:

Component 1 – Develops research and practical skills through exploration of different Dance practitioners, dance styles and performances and the interrelationships that are essential to the performance art.

Component 2 – This component develops students understanding of different styles of dance through practical workshops, rehearsal of performance material and through their development of ideas in planning, rehearsing and the performance of a chosen dance style.

Component 3 – This component requires the students to culminate all their skills learnt throughout the course in developing a workshop performance within a set amount of time from a brief set by Pearson. Student can work in groups of 2-7 and will be given 3 hours to respond to the brief. This component is marked externally.
