<p>Summary:</p> <p>The qualification is split into 2 parts: Unit 201E: Live Performance – RSL issues brief with a thematic content, in November of examining year. External assessment window begins in January and ends at Easter, giving 12 weeks for students to complete 3 tasks: Task 1 – Research repertoire and develop understanding of how to perform chosen repertoire Task 2 – Rehearse and Perform chosen repertoire Task 3- Evaluate performance taking into consideration feedback. Unit 202: Performing Text – This unit develops students understanding of different Acting repertoire, including classical and modern texts, and require analysis of the chosen texts, a performance and an evaluation of performance.
