

## Subject: English language and English literature – KS4

Summary:  
Year 10 and 11 follow a highly focused English language and literature curriculum that develops the skills required to be successful in their examinations. For English language the course followed is WJEC Eduqas 9-1. For English literature it is Edexcel 9-1.

English language:  
There are two papers that students have to complete alongside a spoken language element. Component 1 is the 20<sup>th</sup> Century fiction extract and narrative writing paper. This lasts 1 hour and 45 minutes. The second paper, Component 2, is the 19<sup>th</sup> Century and 21<sup>st</sup> Century non-fiction extracts and the transactional writing paper. Students have 2 hours to complete this paper. Finally, Component 3 is the spoken language element whereby students have to write about a topic of their choice and deliver it to an audience and answer questions on their subject.

English literature:  
Students will complete two papers.  
On paper 1, students will answer questions on The Tragedy of Macbeth by William Shakespeare and An Inspector Calls by J.B.Priestley. Students have 1 hour and 45 minutes to answer these questions.  
In light of Covid-19, paper 2 looks different this year. Students will only answer the questions relating to A Christmas Carol by Charles Dickens. Students have 1 hour and 20 minutes to answer these questions.  
Both examinations are closed book.
