<p>Summary:</p> <p>Paper 1: Global Geographical Issues. Students will study Hazardous earth, development dynamics and challenges of an urbanising world. This will focus on areas such as climate change, tropical cyclones, tectonics and a specific study on India and Mumbai.</p> <p>Paper 2: UK geographical issues. This includes sub topics on Coastal change and conflict and river processes and pressures. Additionally, students do a case study on the evolving human landscape and then conduct a fieldwork investigation on one physical and one human study.</p> <p>Paper 3: People and Environment issues.
