Summary:

The BTEC Music Award qualification comprises of 4 units:

The exam and core unit are mandatory.

The internal units are optional and the student needs to complete at least 2 of these units to gain the full qualification.

Unit 1- Music Industry

This unit focusses on understanding the roles and structures within the music industry and how they work together.

Unit 2 – Creating a Music Product

This unit focusses on developing the skills in producing a concert, taking on the roles and leading the group in the organisation, rehearsal, promotion and execution of a musical event.

Unit 5 – This unit introduces the importance of goal setting, rehearsal and planning and prepares the student for a solo and group performance.

Unit 7- This unit introduces the music software available in school and how to use this software to create a piece of music for film.

Unit 6 – This unit introduces the techniques and equipment used to create a multitrack recording.
