## **Covid Vaccination Update**

The School Age Immunisation Service (SAIS) team will be visiting Campsmount on 12th - 14th October to offer all children aged 12 to 15 years the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccination.

Children who are aged between 12 years old and 15 years old at the time the School Age Immunisation Service (SAIS) team visits the school, will be offered a vaccination as part of the in-school vaccination programme.

Like all school-based vaccination programmes, the vaccines will be administered by healthcare staff working closely with the school and following the usual approach to school-based immunisation.

For children aged 12 to 15 years, consent will be sought by the SAIS provider from the parent or person with parental responsibility in the same way as for any other school vaccination programme. A consent form and information leaflet provided by the SAIS team will be used to seek parental consent. The letters and consent form should be delivered to school next week and then sent home with students. Please be aware that school staff will not be involved in gaining consent for this vaccination, this will be done via the SAIS team only.

Parents will also be provided with a contact number for the SAIS team in case of any queries, however if you have any questions in the meantime, please contact the Academy.
