As you are aware the School Age Immunisation Service (SAIS) team will be visiting Campsmount on 12th - 14th October to offer all children aged 12 to 15 years the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccination.

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Like all school-based vaccination programmes, the vaccines will be administered by healthcare staff working closely with the school and following the usual approach to school-based immunisation.

A consent form, letter and information booklet has been issued to all eligible students today. Please read the information carefully and complete and return the consent form to the Academy by Thursday 7th October. Please be aware that school staff will not be involved in gaining consent for this vaccination, this will be done via the consent form from the SAIS team only.

Any students who did not collect an information pack and consent form today can collect one from Reception on Monday.
