### **Covid-19 Vaccinations**



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As you are aware the School Age Immunisation Service (SAIS) team will be visiting Campsmount next week on 12th - 14th October to offer all children aged 12 to 15 years the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccination.

Like all school-based vaccination programmes, the vaccines will be administered by healthcare staff working closely with the school and following the usual approach to school-based immunisation. A contact number for the SAIS team has been provided should you have any queries.

Please remember, if you or your child develops symptoms of Covid-19 you must stay at home and arrange to have a PCR test. The main symptoms of COVID-19 are a new continuous cough, a high temperature, a loss of, or a change in, your normal sense of taste or smell. If the test is positive you must isolate as per government guidelines. If you live in the same household as someone with COVID-19 you will not be required to self-isolate if you are fully vaccinated or aged under 18 years and 6 months.

People who live in the same household as someone with COVID-19 can also take a PCR test, as they are at higher risk of being infected even if they do not have symptoms, however they do not need to self-isolate whilst waiting for their result.
