Academy Uniform and Equipment Reminder

Dear Parents,

I would like to take this opportunity to wish you all a happy New Year as we welcome our students back to Campsmount for the start of the new term.

Positive routines are a key aspect in ensuring that we continue to provide the best possible learning environment for all of our students. A key routine in supporting us to ensure the best climate for learning is that all students adhere to our school uniform policy.

Please find below a reminder of the academy uniform policy. All students are required to wear the correct academy uniform at all times.

Required

- Campsmount blazer
- White shirt; cotton-type, plain white shirt or blouse with a collar, must be buttoned up to the collar and tucked in
- Black trousers; plain black, non jean-type material, loose fitting/not 'skinny fit' **or** Campsmount skirt
- Campsmount tie, clipped over the fastened top button
- School shoes; plain black, leather-type shoes, no boots

Optional

- V-neck jumper; plain black, worn under the blazer, may be worn during the winter months
- Belts may be worn with school trousers only, however must be plain and black

Please note that the following items are **not permitted**:


- Jewellery, except for one small stud earring in each ear lobe and a wrist watch
- No mobile phones. Whilst students are in the academy mobile phones to remain switched off and remain in school bags throughout the day
- *Please note that these items will be confiscated when sighted by staff*
- Casual shoes, trainers, boots or stiletto heels. School shoes (not 'pumps') to be loaned to students not wearing school shoes by Campsmount. Please note there are exceptions/passes for an identified medical or SEND need
- No hoodies or sweatshirts to be worn both in or out of the Academy building
- Coats, jackets or hats must not be worn inside the Academy building
- No false eye lashes, false nails or nail polish
- No extreme hairstyles or colours, natural hair colours only
- *One-week period for correction*

A further, and important routine is that all students arrive with the correct equipment to access all of their lessons. All students must have a **pen, pencil and ruler**. Missing equipment is to be provided by
