This two-year qualification is equivalent to 1 A Level and covers the key knowledge and practical		
skills required in preparation for working in the ICT industry or going on to an ICT related degree		
course at university. You will study a broad and stimulating curriculum consisting of 5 units over		
the two years that are relevant to today's ICT industry.		
Assessment takes place in the form of two external examinations and three portfolios. The		
portfolio units combine theoretical research as well as practical exercises. Each Portfolio is		
assessed internally and will show your understanding of a specific standard. At the end of the		
course you will be awarded a pass, merit, distinction or distinction*.		
This qualification is designed to enable you to enter employment or to progress to further		
education/higher education. Example areas might include digital design, networking and		

computer maintenance & support.
